THE EXHIBITION

CELEBRATING NAIDOC Art Exhibition, at the Cassino Art Gallery 13 June to 18 July 2026

THE ARTWORK

The artwork must be a corporeal artwork that is suitable for the spaces in Cassino Art Gallery. If any hazardous materials or dangerous installation is included in your work (including performance work), you must contact the Gallery Manager for prior approval on 0418 485 770, or via email on cassinoartgallery@gmail.com.

Cassino Art Gallery reserves the right not to accept any entry that is deemed offensive, derogatory, or racist.

The exhibition is curated. Cassino Art Gallery holds vetting rights to any submissions made. There will be NO exhibiting fee for this exhibition.

PAYMENT

The Exhibitor will deduct a commission of 20% from the sale price of any work sold for the duration of the exhibition.

Payment (less commission) will be made to the artist as soon as possible after the exhibition is closed and the sale price is paid in full by the purchaser.

Note: there will be no commission charged on kids' sales.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

The parties acknowledge that the consideration due or payable for the supply of any goods, services or any other things under this agreement have been calculated without regard to, and is exclusive of any GST.

TRANSPORT AND INSTALLATION

The artist is responsible for arranging and paying for the cost of packing and transport of the work to and from the exhibition premises as well as transport insurance. All specialised installation costs requiring additional stands or structures are the artist's responsibility.

INSURANCE

The Exhibitor will do its best to ensure the work is always handled with care.

The work will be displayed and handled at the Artist's risk. The Exhibitor accepts no liability for loss or damage for loss or damage of the work while on Exhibitor's premises or in transit, and recommends the artist insure their work.

COPYRIGHT

- (a) The Exhibitor acknowledges that the work loaned remains the property of the Artist and the Exhibitor may not reproduce the work or any part of it unless agreed to in writing and only for the purposes of:
 - (i) Publicity and critical review
 - (ii) Catalogue and display material
 - (iii) Creating a non-commercial archive and non-lending reference or database of the exhibition
- (b) The Artist warrants that they are the owner of all copyright in the work.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Exhibitor will acknowledge the Artist where possible, in publicity for the exhibition and including any catalogue.

INTEGRITY OF THE WORK

The Exhibitor will not alter, modify or destroy the work, nor do anything that may compromise the integrity of the Work. The Artist will be notified as soon as possible of any maintenance or repairs that may need attention during the exhibition so that the Artist can approve the repairs in a timely manner.

CELEBRATING NAIDOC ART EXHIBITION 2026

1. Details about the exhibition as published on official Cassino Art Gallery communication platforms including but not limited to the Cassino Art Gallery website, Facebook, electronic entry application forms and promotion material, all form part of the terms and conditions of entry as stated in this document and apply to all entries for the Cassino Art Gallery CELEBRATING NAIDOC Art Exhibition.
2. By submitting an entry, entrants shall be considered to have acknowledged and accepted these terms and conditions and agreed to be bound by them.
3. Entrants in breach of any of these terms and conditions are subject to disqualification from the Cassino Art Gallery CELEBRATING NAIDOC Art Exhibition.
4. The Cassino Art Gallery CELEBRATING NAIDOC Art Exhibition is open to any age. Those under 18 years must have the signed permission of a parent or a guardian.

Prize (if applicable).

5. There is a commission of 20% on the sale price paid to Cassino Art Gallery for any work sold. Commission not applicable to "Youth Creative" (school student) artwork.

7. Entries received after the submission deadline will not be accepted. Cassino Art Gallery accepts no responsibility for late or lost entries. Entries close on May 30th. A maximum of 5 artworks may be submitted.
8. All entrants must submit their name, contact details (phone and email), dimension of the artwork, title of the work, sale price and their bank details. Each artwork must be clearly signed by the artist.
9. Entrants may submit a written Artist's Statement, maximum of 300 words to be included in the Artists' Statement folder on display in the gallery (by the discretion of the Gallery Manager) for the duration of the exhibition. This is not mandatory.
10. Artworks must be delivered to Cassino Art Gallery (148 Barker St, Casino) on the 6th June 2026 between 10am and 2pm.

Warranties

11. Each entrant warrants that their entry, including the written submission, is the entrant's original work, that any intellectual property rights and copyrights arising in connection with that entry belong to the entrant.

Liabilities

12. Cassino Art Gallery and its officers, and agents do not accept any liability, however arising, including liability for negligence, for any accident, loss, injury or damage arising at any time out of or in connection with the Cassino Art Gallery CELEBRATING NAIDOC Art Exhibition except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded.
13. Each entrant indemnifies Cassino Art Gallery against any liability or loss arising from any infringement or alleged infringement of any Intellectual Property rights or Moral Rights in the artwork.
